

Peaks & Prairies Golf Course Superintendents Association Scholarship Application Booklet

General

The Peaks & Prairies GCSA Scholarship Program was developed to recognize outstanding students planning careers in golf course management. The Peaks & Prairies Golf Course Superintendents Association, at their discretion, administer the awards and determines the dollar amounts each year.

The Peaks & Prairies GCSA Scholarship Committee will review applications. All decisions of the committee will be final. Scholarship recipients will be announced during the Peaks & Prairies GCSA Fall Meeting & Trade Show and the scholarship check, with a letter of acknowledgement, will be mailed by December 15. All scholarship award checks will be made payable to the applicant.

Eligibility

- 1. Applicant must be a current member of the Peaks & Prairies GCSA.
- 2. The student must be studying a field related to golf course management or golf course maintenance.
- 3. The student must be enrolled full-time at an accredited institution of higher learning, have completed at least the freshman term and have at least a 3.0 GPA in their major and a 2.5 average overall.
- 4. The applicant must have a minimum of one (1) season of employment in golf course maintenance.
- 5. Past winners are eligible to apply the following year.
- 6. Children of Peaks & Prairies GCSA members are eligible to apply and receive this award, but are limited to a total of one association scholarship award a year.
- 7. Although any number of students from the same family may apply, only one student per family will be eligible to receive an award.

Criteria for Selection

- 1. Applicants will be evaluated based on academic skill, potential to become a leading professional, employment history, extracurricular activities and the recommendation of a previous superintendent and a current academic adviser.
- 2. Financial need is not a factor in the selection.
- 3. In the event that the Scholarship Committee feels there are no qualified applicants during any given year, the award may be withheld during that year.

How to apply

- 1. Application must be typed, dated and signed.
- 2. College transcripts must be received no later than September 20.
- 3. The person giving the reference must send personal reference letters directly to the Peaks & Prairies GCSA office.
- 4. Completed application form must be received in the Peaks & Prairies GCSA office no later than September 20.
